





FROM THE PASTOR'S PEN



Matthew 16:13-20

"You are the Christ, the Son of the living God."

It is important to read today's Gospel and next week's Gospel as two parts of a single story. This week we hear Jesus ask his disciples about his identity. Simon Peter answers, identifying Jesus as the Messiah, the Son of God. He said "You are the Christ, the Son of the Living God." Because of Simon Peter's response, Jesus calls him the "rock." He said, "And so I say to you, you are Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church, and the gates of the netherworld shall not prevail against it." Peter came to this knowledge, because of the relationship he shared with Jesus and what God was able to reveal in and through that relationship. How do we build up that relationship? The simple answer is by loving God. The only way to know God is to love God. Our minds will never fully grasp the mystery of God, but our hearts and souls can learn to love the mystery.


